

TREATY EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

The 2022-2023 school year will mark the thirteenth year of Treaty Education in Manitoba. Kudos to the province's school leaders, education practitioners, school communities, and teachers who have embraced Treaty Education, making it a staple in Manitoba's K-12 classrooms.



In 2022 – 2023, The Treaty Relations Commission of Manitoba (TRCM) is offering the following five synchronous online sessions:

- September 19 & 20, 2022 – Open K-12 Regional Treaty Education Training
- November 23, 2022 – Grade 12 SIC: Treaty Education Training
- December 6 & 7, 2022 – School Admin Treaty Education Training
- January 31 & February 1, 2023 – Open K-12 Regional Treaty Education Training
- February 21 & 22, 2023 – French Language K-12 Treaty Education Training

These sessions will be delivered live, allowing participants to engage in discussions and meaningful dialogue with presenters and other registrants. The two-day gatherings will explore the historical and contemporary contexts of Treaties as well as best-practices and tips for successful Treaty Education implementation. 
